- 2) TAKE A PHOTO OF THE VEHICLE'S LICENSE PLATE AND SEND IT TO A FRIEND OR LOVED ONE WITH THE TIME AND LOCATION OF DEPARTURE.
- 3) NEVER GET INTO A VEHICLE WITH ANYBODY YOU DO NOT KNOW OR HAVE AGREED TO RIDE WITH.
- 4) TRY TO TRAVEL WITH FRIENDS OR FAMILY.
- 5) USE YOUR PHONE TO SEND OUT ALERTS AS SOON AS YOU BECOME CONCERNED ABOUT THE RIDE.
- 6) LOOK AT THE CONDITION OF THE VEHICLE'S INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR. DO NOT USE A VEHICLE YOU DO NOT FEEL SAFE RIDING IN.
