Round Table Introductions

DART App Overview

Joe Scruggs from DelDOT introduced the new DTC App with the different capabilities it will have. The new App will indicate to users what is local to where an individual is located. And it will show the bus in real time by GPS. Some of the features on the App are:

- Alerts and Press Releases
- o Bus Routes
- o New addition Trip Planner which has a reverse to schedule the return trip as well.
- o Purchase of tickets
- o Contact, About Us (DART services Information)

Responses so far have been good Apple 4.8 and Android 5. The next major project to the App is adding Paratransit. Information will include:

- O Where's my bus?
- o Complete schedule for the week
- Ability to set up trips

Review of procedure for Violent Behavior on Paratransit and Fixed Route- Belinda Strickland
