Call to Order

Blake Roberts, Chair, called meeting to order. July meeting minutes were approved via email.

Round Table Introductions

Update on COVID and Ridership- John Sisson, CEO

Since the pandemic Fixed Route ridership has dropped down 50%, Paratransit 35% and SEPTA 75%. Before COVID there were 143,000 Fixed Route riders now down to 84,466. Paratransit in March 2019 19,112 this year March 2020 down 7,700. Cleaning and mask requirement until the Governor moves the state to phase III plan. DTC has also, suspended partnerships with agencies such as Easter Seals and MMC.

60 million used to offset loss of revenue and cleaning. Reduce subsidy from DelDOT. DTC has not laid off any workers nor have we cut service. In October Fixed Route service will be expanded in New Castle County on the weekend. Some of the routes are Routes 2, 6, 5, 13 and 40. DTC has been awarded two grants, 2.5 million will be used to install solar panels at the parking lot in Dover which will help save energy and keep snow off buses. AIM grant from FTA will be used in Georgetown \$317,692 to start Mobility On Demand. DTC will work with Veya which will allow any type vehicle that can get into the system to be used to transport riders. This should be out for service in the spring or summer next year. Delaware was one of 33 states to get a proposal. On November 9, 2020 DART will start the annual Stuff the Bus drive.

Prepay Program Update- Lori Yeager, Paratransit Support Service Manager

The testing will start soon to see how the program is going to work. There will be 6 to 7 participants. Riders will have to call and pay with their cards. The funds will be placed on their account and funds will be deducted when the trip is booked.

Website Accessibility for Visually Impaired- Sara Fuller, Marketing

Marketing Department will continually look for tools and technology to make everything accessible to the consumer by looking into the features found not only embedded with the web technology which makes it easier for those with screen readers, and being cognizant of creating accessible materials, whether as PDF files, videos or accessible schedules. More videos are being done and with more descriptive audio in combination with closed captioning, which can assist those with low vision, as well as sharing the accessible formats outside of the website on DTC's socials and other electronic sources which persons with disabilities that are not just related to vision impairments. Marketing will assist EDTAC with ideas to help with recruitment of new members.
