DART's 15th Annual Stuff the Bus Food Drive Nets Over 10 tons of food for Delaware's Food Bank and Needy

DART First State announced today that its 15th annual Stuff The Bus Thanksgiving Food drive collected 10.8 tons (21,595 pounds) of food. The week-long DART food drive took place from November 5 to November 9 at Walmart in Milford, ACME in Dover, ACME in Fairfax Shopping Center, and Rodney Square in Wilmington. The Food Bank of Delaware will distribute the donated food through its more than 440 hunger relief partners to Delaware residents in need.
