Wilmington Construction Projects Require Relocation of Bus Stop on King Street at Library

Two simultaneous construction projects require DART to revise its detour plan in downtown Wilmington. Currently the King Street side of Rodney Square is closed due to the City of Wilmington's Landscape Improvement Project. In addition, the Wilmington Library has recently closed for renovation, which will now impact the DART bus stop located on the side of the Library, at the corner of King & 10th Streets.

The Wilmington Library Construction Project will require the sidewalks on King Street and 10th Street sides to be closed for the next year until approximately November 2013. Effective Monday, October 15, 2012, DART will shift its bus stop on King south of 10th Street to either King Street just north of 11th Street at the former U.S. Post Office or on King Street at 8th Street, depending on the route. Route specific boarding locations are listed below and will be posted on the bus stop, as well as be listed on the website at www.DartFirstState.com.

Effective Monday, October 15, 2012, DART's revised detour plan will be as follows:

Rts. 1, 3, 4, 5, 9, 15, 17, 19 & 30 – Board on King Street north of 11th Street at former U.S. Post Office

Rts. 22, 23, 25, 33, 34, 36, 39, 40, 41, 42, 54 & 55 – Board on King Street at 9th Street

Rts. 3, 4, 9, 16, 24 – Board on King Street at 8th Street
