Changes Coming to Bus Boarding Locations Along King Street in Downtown Wilmington

With the completion of the first phase of the Rodney Square Beautification project, DART will adjust bus route boarding locations along King Street. Beginning Monday, February 11, 2013, select bus routes will resume serving the King Street side of Rodney Square, and route-specific boarding locations along King Street will be adjusted to better distribute the number of passengers at any given stop.

The King Street side of Rodney Square, which has been closed since July 2012, will reopen and be served by Routes 4, 5, 19, 30, 33, 34, 36, 39, 40, 41, 42, 54 and 55.

Route specific boarding locations are listed below and will be posted on the bus stop, as well as be listed on the website at www.DartFirstState.com. Most bus routes serve multiple bus stops along King Street, allowing passengers to choose the most convenient stop.

King Street north of 11th Street at the former U.S. Post Office - Routes 1, 3, 9, 15, 17, 22, 23 and 25.

King Street at 9th Street - Routes 1, 3, 4, 5, 9, 15, 17, 22, 23, 24 and 25.

King Street at 8th Street - Routes 2, 6, 10, 11, 12, 16, 20, 21, 28, 35, 38, 45 and 301.

King Street at 6th Street - Routes 1, 3, 4, 5, 9, 15, 17, 19, 22, 23, 24, 25, 30, 33, 34, 36, 39, 40, 41, 42, 54 and 55.

The Library bus stop located on King Street at 10th Street remains closed until the completion of the Wilmington Library Construction Project in late 2013.
